2012 STEWARDSHIP CAMPAIGN UPDATE

Thank you for your response to our new stewardship campaign! In order to make sure that your donations get credited properly, please write separate checks for each fund to which you are donating, and indicate either "Operating Fund" or "Trustees' Fund" in the memo line.

Operating Fund

As of 1/20/2012, we have received \$175,832 in pledges to the Operating Fund. However, we still have a long way to go. The 2012 budget approved by the Church Council estimates that our pledge income will be \$247,000 (the same as last year). We're still waiting for a large number of folks who pledged last year to make pledges for this year. Pledge cards can be found in the pew pockets and on the table in the Narthex. Please return a pledge card as soon as possible!

Trustees' Buildings & Properties Fund

As of 1/2/2012, the total number of pledgers is 31 for a total pledge of \$16,582.81.
